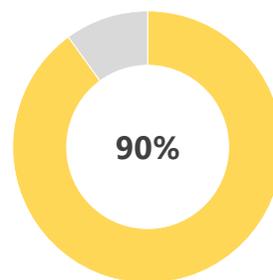
- › Longest operating private power producer in Indonesia since 1993
- › Serves industrial customers in one of the largest, most developed, and integrated industrial estate (IE) area in Indonesia
- › Integrated IUPTLU¹ license provides exclusivity to supply power to Industrial Customers within its designated area
- › Total installed generating capacity of 1,144 MW + 45.7 MWp
 - › 864 MW – Gas-fired Power Plant²
 - › 280 MW – Steam Power Plant, of which 70 MW of biomass co-firing capacity³
 - › 45.7 MWp Solar Power, with another 11.4 MWp in progress
- › First PPU⁴ listed in Indonesian Stock Exchange (IDX) [POWR:IJ]
- › Since its IPO (2016-2024), the Company has consistently delivered a robust average dividend yield⁵ of 9.1% and strong average ROE of 13.3%
- › The Company's dividend yield ranks within the Top 25 on the IDX⁶
- › Repeat debt issuer in international debt market listed on Singapore Exchange (SGX) (2010, 2012, 2016, and 2025)

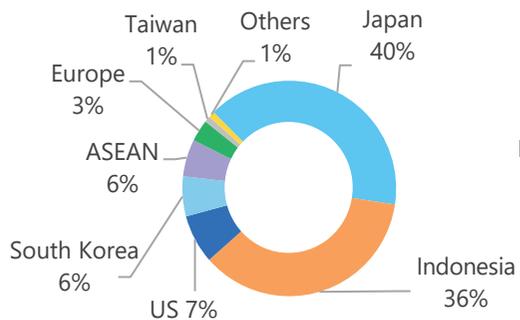

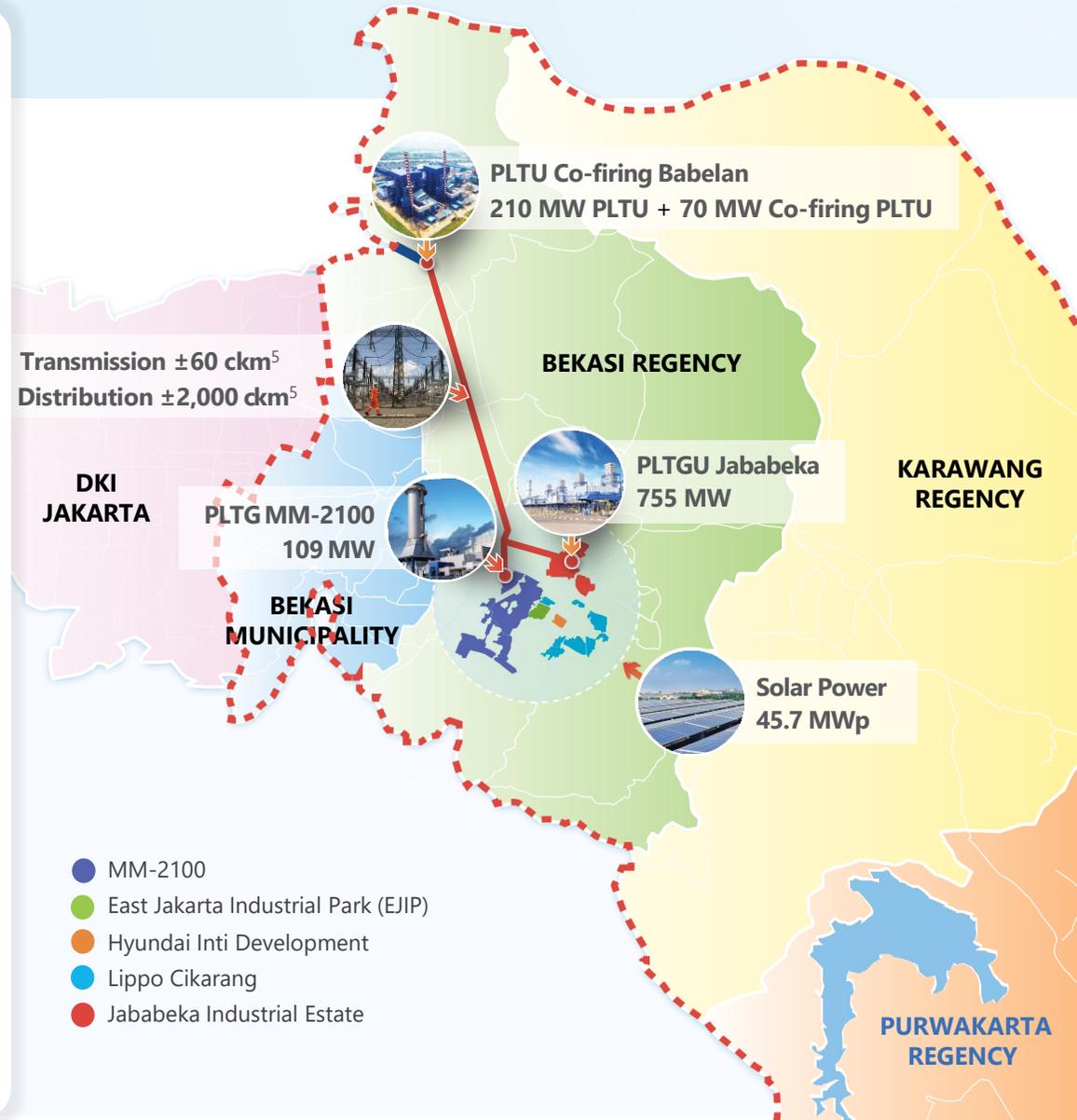
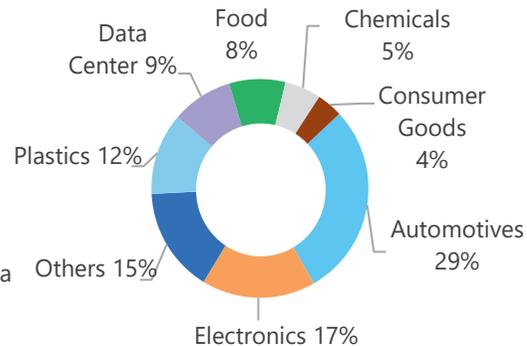

Update on Company's Expansion Projects

Solar Power



- **2018**
Installed 52.5 kWp solar power at Jababeka office
- **2019**
Started providing customers with solar power as a renewable energy source
- **2024**
Started a 5 MWp ground-mounted solar power at its operational office in Babelan. The project is currently in progress
- **2025**
Expanded solar power capacity to 45.7 MWp (2024: 35.8 MWp), with another 11.4 MWp in progress
- **2026**
An additional 24.3 MWp of solar power capacity will be added in 2026

Biomass Co-firing



- **2021**
Installed biomass handling system in PLTU Co-firing Babelan, allowing biomass utilization for up to 28 MW of capacity generation
- **1H25**
Expanded biomass co-firing capacity by up to 70 MW of capacity generation
- **2025**
Scaled up co-firing PLTU initiative increasing biomass generation by 155.5% from ~80 GWh in 2024 to ~205 GWh in 2025
- **2026**
As part of our ongoing commitment, we will gradually increase the utilization of biomass, supporting our transition toward cleaner and more sustainable energy sources

Gas Engine



- **2024**
The Company has started to construct a gas engine power plant project with the capacity of 50 MW to increase operational performance
- **2025**
Gas engine power plant project has reached 93.7% completed
- **2026**
An additional 50 MW is scheduled for commissioning in the first half of 2026, which will increase our power plant capacity

Disclosure Information

On August 14, 2025, the Company made a public disclosure regarding a disruption in its gas supply. For the first time in 32+ years, we faced two unprecedented events occurring at the same time. Yet, we mitigated major risks and ensure continued reliable operations.



Gas Supply Incident Update

- Aug 5, 2025 ● Unplanned shutdown at PT Pertamina EP (“PEP”) Subang Field temporarily affected gas supply to all PEP Western Java customers, including the Company
- Aug 13, 2025 ● PT Perusahaan Gas Negara (Persero) Tbk (“PGN”) reported pressure issues in South Sumatera West Java (“SSWJ”) network, potentially impacting gas supply to our power plant
- Dec 31, 2025 ● Gas supply status summary
 - ✓ PEP : Since the incident up to Dec 31, the average gas supply from PEP was 13 BBTUD
 - ✓ PGN : Gas supply has recovered starting Aug 18, 2025, reaching to average gas supply before the incident
- Feb 26, 2026 ● As of Feb 26, the average gas supply from PEP remains at 13 BBTUD. Following the commissioning of the temporary CO₂ removal facility at end-February 2026, PEP’s gas supply is expected to gradually recover and target fully normalize by June 2026
 - ✓ Since the incident, the Company has continued to **meet 100% of industrial demand**

Next Action Taken

- ✓ We are actively exploring alternative natural gas up to 30 BBTUD from various suppliers, to alleviate gas supply issues. Additionally, we have successfully secured an extra 6 MMSCFD of gas from Akasia Bagus, scheduled to begin by the 1Q of 2026. This new supply will further enhance our supply chain stability and strengthen our long-term resilience.
- ✓ We have initiated an insurance claim to cover the additional costs incurred due to this event. We’re currently in discussions with our insurer.

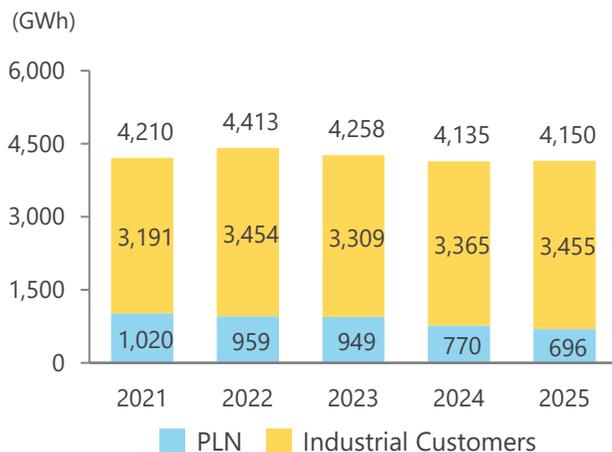

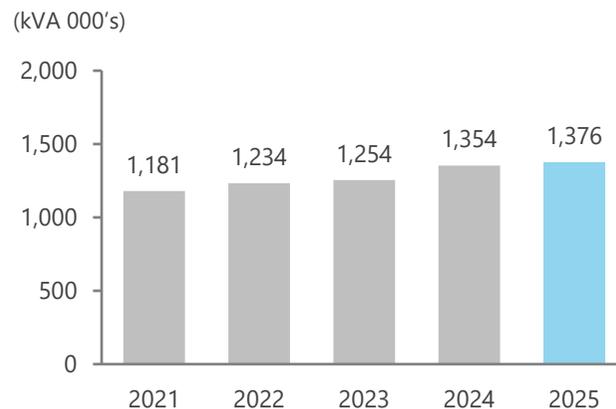

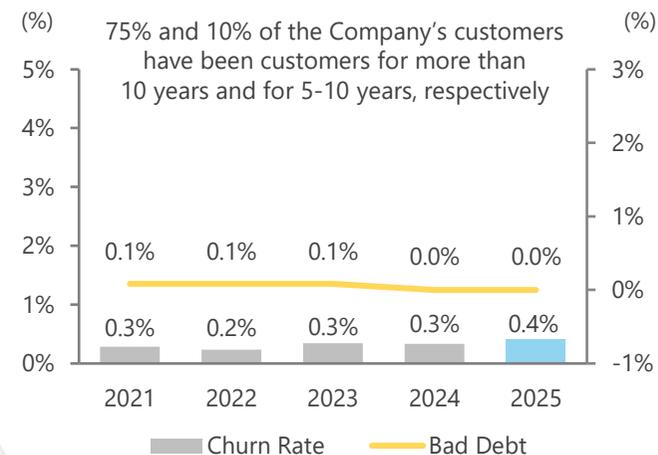
Historical Consumption Growth



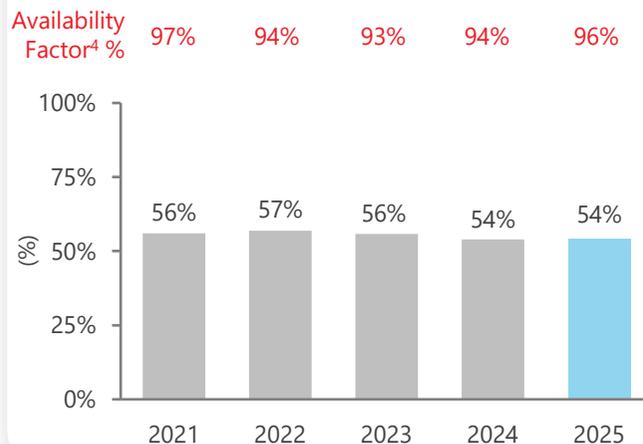
Industrial Customers' Energized¹ Capacity



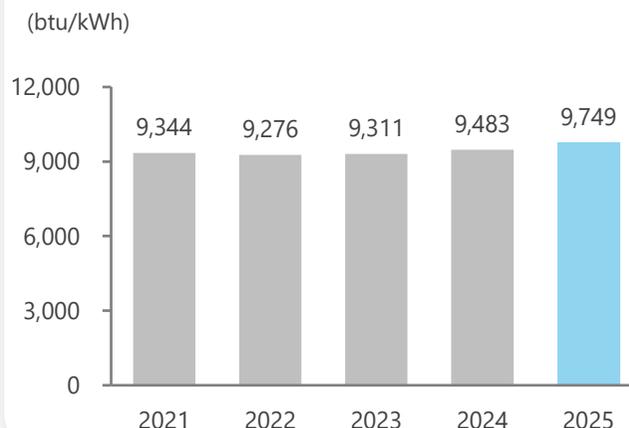
Low Customer Churn Rate² and Bad Debt³



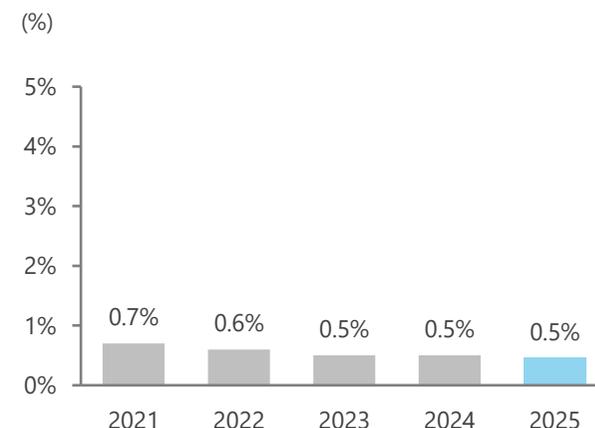
Net Capacity Factor^{4,5}

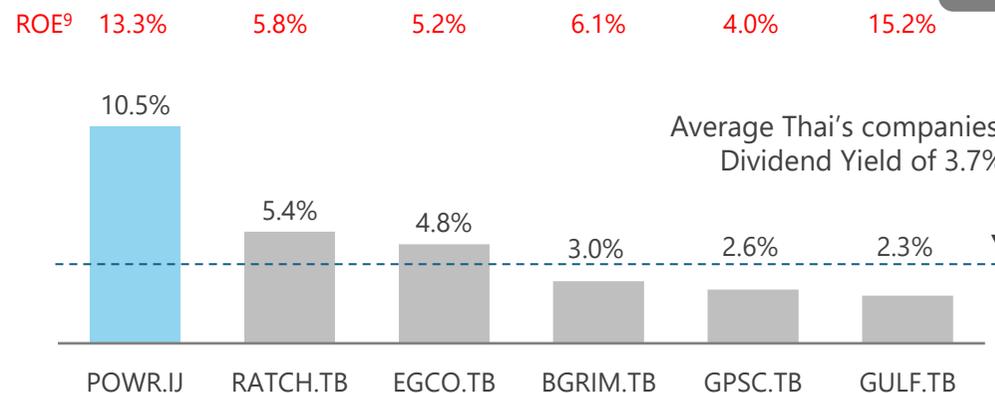

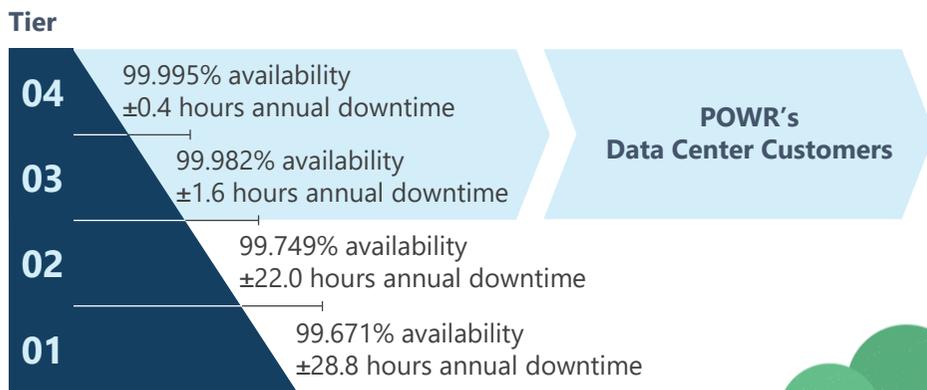

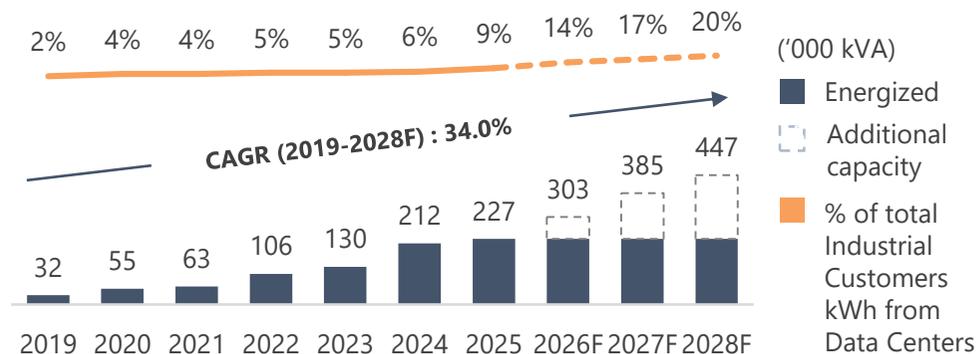
