

Cikarang Listrindo Targets 30 MWp Rooftop Solar Power Capacity in Commemorating the Company's 30th Anniversary (This Press Release is part of the series of Press Releases commemorating the 30th Anniversary of the Company)

Jakarta, August 29, 2023 - PT Cikarang Listrindo Tbk (IDX: POWR), the longest-serving Public Power Utility (PPU) in Indonesia since its operation in 1993, continues to transform in developing sustainable business

for the past 30 years. One of the transformations ongoing is the development of renewable energy through the providing of Rooftop Solar Power. Currently, the Company has successfully increased the Rooftop Solar Power capacity to 15.4 MWp as of August 28, 2023, making it the PPU with the largest capacity of Rooftop Solar Power in Indonesia. There are still ongoing projects with a total capacity of 12.6 MWp. The Company is determined to develop a total of 30 MWp of Rooftop Solar Power this year while celebrating the Company's 30th anniversary.

Every year, the Company strives to continually add 10 MWp of Rooftop Solar Panel with the hope of becoming a PPU with the largest Solar Power capacity in Indonesia someday. Currently, the largest operational Solar Power in Indonesia is Solar Power Likupang, with an installed capacity of 21 MWp located

in the Wineru Village, East Likupang District, North Minahasa Regency, North Sulawesi Province.

Rooftop Solar Power generates renewable energy and provides environmentally friendly and sustainable energy solutions that directly contribute to the reduction of Greenhouse Gas (GHG) emissions in industrial areas. By the end of 2022, the Company's entire Rooftop Solar Power has generated approximately 8,609 MWh of renewable cumulative energy. The energy

production from Rooftop Solar Power from 2019 to July 2023 has reached 19,718 MWh. With this contribution, the Company has successfully reduced emissions by approximately 21.7 kTon of CO₂ over nearly 5 years, equivalent to the carbon absorption of more than 210,000 adult trees.

Furthermore, PT Cikarang Listrindo Tbk prioritizes sustainability principles by taking concrete steps to reduce GHG emissions. The Company has set targets to reduce GHG emissions by 10% in 2025 and 20% in 2030. These actions are also in line with Indonesia's contribution Nationally Determined to the Contribution (NDC) in the energy sector.

The Company's actions also align with Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) No. 7 and 13, related

to access to clean energy and environmental protection. As a transparent measure toward the environment, the Company regularly reports emissions to the public through the Company's Sustainability Report, which is certified by international independent parties. The emissions of SO₂, NO₂, and particulates from the GSPP Jababeka and GFPP MM-2100 in the first half of 2023 are <4 mg/Nm³, <174 mg/Nm³, and <9 mg/Nm3, respectively. Based on the analysis, the Company's exhaust gas quality is well below the standards set by the Ministry of Environment and Forestry (KLHK), which are 150 mg/Nm³, 400 mg/Nm³, and 30 mg/Nm³, respectively. Similarly, the emissions of SO₂, NO₂, and particulates from the CFPP Babelan in the first half of 2023 are <163 mg/Nm³, <181 mg/Nm³, and <32 mg/Nm³, respectively. Based on the analysis, these parameters are also well below the quality standards set by KLHK, which are 550 mg/Nm³, 550 mg/Nm³, and 100 mg/Nm³, respectively.

In the spirit of celebrating its 30 years in operation, the Company reaffirms its commitment to prioritize sustainability values, social contributions, and environmental protection. The greatest contribution is sought with the highest commitment to add value to stakeholders, including the local community and the environment. With the slogan "Light that Brings Goodness," the Company encourages its employees, both individually and organizationally, to bring positive impacts to their surroundings, representing the spirit of the Company's founders from 30 years ago.

Cikarang Listrindo at a glance

Cikarang Listrindo is the first private power utility listed in the Indonesian Stock Exchange since 2016. The Company is also the pioneer private power utility in Indonesia that started serving customers since 1993 and currently serving more than 2,500 industrial customers in five industrial estates in Cikarang, and has also supplied electricity to Perusahaan Listrik Negara (PLN) since 1996. The Company's generating capacity of 1,144 MW added with renewable energy Solar Rooftop of 15.4 MWp as of August 2023, makes the Company as one of the biggest capacity power producer in Indonesia.
