

Powering Goodness to Sodana Village

Jakarta, October 14, 2022 - On August 14-19, 2022, PT Cikarang Listrindo Tbk (IDX: POWR) (the "Company")



with the spirit of "Powering Goodness" together with Solar Chapter Madison, carried out the construction of water infrastructure for the villagers in Sodana Village.

Solar Chapter Madison itself is a non-profit organization founded in 2017 and aims to accommodate the young generation of the Indonesian nation to contribute to the Indonesia people in need in a sustainable manner.

Sodana Village is located in West Sumba Regency, East Nusa Tenggara (NTT). The

village consists of about 600 villagers, most of the people make living as farmers, where the availability of water is a major factor for the livelihood of the villagers. This village is one of many villages in NTT that is experiencing water shortages due to the climate and lack of supporting infrastructure. The location of the village is classified as a remote village, isolated from most of the crowd centers and transportation connection points, with the distance from the village to the capital of West Sumba Regency, Waikabubak City about 20 km with a distance of about 1 hour.

Due to the dry geographical condition of the NTT area, with an average annual rainfall of only 800-1900 mm per year with an average of around 70-150 rainy days per year, the main problem for villagers is finding a source of clean water. Every day, the villagers of Sodana Village have to walk about 5 km to the nearest clean water source due to lack of infrastructure. It is also not enough to take water in one trip to meet the water consumptions of each family, so all the mothers and children of the villagers need to take several trips that consumed 2-3 hours per day to meet the entire



family's water consumptions. Not to mention, children's learning and playing activities are reduced due to this necessity. For these reasons, Sodana Village was chosen by this partnership to support its infrastructure.



Water infrastructure is built with a water pump design system that able to pumping 5 m3 of water every hour using renewable energy source in the form of 24 Solar Power Plants (PLTS) with a capacity of 330 Wp. Through this infrastructure, the villagers of Sodana Villager has the easy access to clean water from the three public taps that are provided at a maximum distance of 3 minutes from people's homes and meet the water consumptions of the entire village population. It is hoped that this will change the lifestyle of the villagers for the better, because they will have more time to do positive and quality activities.



Through this program, we believe it will have a positive impact on other issues such as children's education, domestic violence, malnutrition, and poverty that help achieve the goals of Sustainable Development Goals



(SDGs) number 2 (No Hunger), 3 (Good Health and Welfare), 6 (Clean Water and Sanitation), and 8 (Economic Growth and Decent Work) which are also the focus of the Company's SDGs.

The Company together with Solar Chapter Madison will continue to monitor these facilities and ensure the facilities receive a regular maintenance from the monthly fees collected from each family in Sodana Village. It is hoped that this arrangement will also instill a sense of ownership and responsibility of the villagers toward the facility. This will be the first step for Sodana

Village to become an independent village and can slowly solve challenges of the village in the future
