Cikarang Listrindo in Empowering Women and Promoting Sustainable Education

Cikarang, 5 December 2024 – PT Cikarang Listrindo Tbk (“the Company”) has reaffirmed its active commitment to driving positive change in environmental sustainability. This time, the Company contributes to one of the key themes of the Indonesian Ministry of Environment’s turnaround agenda about women’s empowerment. The Company emphasizes its role through education and the development of micro, small, and medium enterprises (MSMEs), aligning with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) supported by the Indonesian Government.

With the spirit of "Light that Brings Goodness," the Company, through its Babelan power plant, has initiated various environmental and social programs, including a scholarship programs now in its third batch in 2024, as well as women empowerment initiatives in Muara Bakti Village, Babelan, Bekasi.



Women’s Scholarship Program

In its execution, the Company collaborates with the Karya Salemba Empat Foundation (KSE) to ensure the programs are targeted and beneficial for the recipients.

The third batch of scholarships for the 2024 academic year has been awarded to 30 female students, continuing the success of the program initiated since 2019, which has supported a total of 48 scholars, comprising 26 female students and 22 male students.



In the scholarship program, the Company, in collaboration with KSE, also prepares recipients with skills and experience in entrepreneurship. Scholarship recipients are encouraged to participate in structured and impactful community empowerment activities. One tangible outcome of this effort was the “CL Women POWR Camp 2024,” held from November 15 to 21, 2024. The event was attended by 30 scholarship recipients from the third batch representing various state universities; 10 female leaders of university chapters from UNJ, UI, UIN Jakarta, and IPB; 15 members of youth organizations and community partners; and 60 participants from UNJ, UI, UIN Jakarta, IPB, and UNTIRTA.

During the camp, the Company and KSE inspired participants on women empowerment. Various topics were covered, including insights into the Company's electricity industry, women contributions to the sector, career tips, and entrepreneurship knowledge. Participants also received training in self-development, mental health awareness, effective communication, women in leadership, socio-preneurship skills, social media marketing, and sustainable textile and fashion insights. Additionally, the Company organized focus group discussions with participants, who are also stakeholders of the Company.

Furthermore, the women empowerment program focuses on seven local women participating in the production center “SEKAR MUKTI” (Community Creation Hub of Muara Bakti) in Kampung Pasar Emas, Dusun 2B, Muara Bakti Village, Babelan. The Company supports the growth of SEKAR MUKTI by renovating the production center, providing additional training, supplying equipment and tools, funding operational costs, and offering intensive mentorship programs as needed.



The camp concluded with the scholarship recipients' involvement in community empowerment activities in Muara Bakti Village. This involvement resulted in the establishment of SEKAR MUKTI production center, empowering seven local women. Members of SEKAR MUKTI independently presented their products, including beads, bracelets, necklaces, brooches, scarves, and clothing. Coincide with the closing of the “CL Women POWR Camp 2024” on November 21, 2024, the SEKAR MUKTI production center was officially inaugurated, attended by the Risk & Corporate Communication Manager of PT Cikarang Listrindo Tbk, the Community Empowerment Officer of Babelan District, the Welfare Division Head of Muara Bakti Village, and the COO of Karya Salemba Empat Foundation.

These events reflect the Company's commitment to achieving the SDGs, particularly SDG 4 (Quality Education), SDG 5 (Gender Equality), and SDG 8 (Decent Work and Economic Growth), as well as its role in creating positive impacts for society and the environment.
